



**Rural Municipality of Cartier

Public Notice**

Notice is hereby given that no person shall deposit snow upon the travelled portion or shoulder of a municipal road including any ditch thereof in accordance with Resolution of Council No. 25-01 which reads as follows:

“WHEREAS, Section 287 of the Municipal Act states that a municipality has the direction, control and management of municipal roads within its boundaries;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, no person shall drop, throw or otherwise deposit any substance or thing (hereinafter referred to as an “obstruction”), on the travelled portion or shoulder of a municipal road including any ditch thereof that is likely to injure a person or animal or damage a vehicle or in any other way impede the operations of the Municipality;

AND FURTHER THAT, if a person contravenes this requirement, the Municipality shall remove such obstruction and recover any expense it incurs from the person who caused the obstruction by:

- a) levying and collecting the amount as a tax, or
- b) any other means

and in any event, any such recovery of expense shall be payable to the Municipality in like manner as taxes.”

As well, attached is a certified copy of resolution no. 474-10 which further addresses this issue.
